 Dear Brothers and Sisters in Islam,ICLP was first established July 2001 by 3 Muslims who moved to the area for work. These 3 travelled 45 minutes to Prince Frederick, the location of the closest Masjid, to perform Jumua'h prayers.

* Starting in 2003, the community now approximately 5 members, prayed at the Chapel in the Patuxent River Naval Air Station.
* By 2005, the community grew to around 15 members and started to hold Jumua'h in the Lexington Park Library.
* Starting in 2010, after the community grew to over 40 members, ICLP started renting a 1200 sq ft building with a 500 sq ft Musalla as a temporary center.
* Since 2010, the community has grown to over 70 members with the addition of 7 babies, many new families, and about 8 reverts to Islam.

The community has grown to the size where it becomes imperative for us to seek a building and property to establish a permanent Masjid to conduct our religious actives and expand our Dawah program.

## Our Objectives

Insha-Allah, the proposed Islamic Center will:

* Serve as a focal point for the Muslim community in St. Mary's County
* Provide means for daily Salah, Jumua'h, Taraweeh \& Eid Prayers
* Provide weekly evening Hifz and Quran classes for children and adults
* Provide funeral \& family counseling services
* Motivate and involve the community in religious and social activites and services
* Provide Islamic education to the youth through training sessions, camp and establishment of youth programs
